Tour Freedoms Foundation's campus and the Medal of Honor Grove and on Friday. Hear from a local scholar about Valley Forge and visit the National Park, before you partake in a conversation with Edward 'Ned' Hector, a free man of color, Bombardier and Patriot of the American Revolution.

Saturday you will travel by bus to New York City, where you will tour the Statue of Liberty, the beacon of freedom for the United States. You will also explore Ellis Island, and relive the history of the hardships endured by millions of immigrants looking for a new life in the US. As well as having lunch on Ellis Island, you will go to the 9/11 Memorial, site of the largest attack on American soil. The Memorial's twin reflecting pools are each nearly an acre in size and feature the largest manmade waterfalls in North America.
