CELEBRATE CONSTITUTION WEEK



SEPTEMBER 17-23, 2023

Constitution week is observed in America to commemorate the 1787 adoption of our U. S. Constitution. The day of observation is September 17th.

The week was officially enacted on August 2, 1956, by President Dwight D. Eisenhower from a congressional resolution petitioned by the Daughters of the American Revolution, but it was George W Bush who officially declared the inception of Constitution Week in September 2002.

The purpose of the week of observance is to promote study and education about the United States Constitution which was originally adopted by the American Congress of the Confederation on September 17, 1787. Specifically, the Daughters of the American Revolution state the purpose as:

- Emphasize citizens' responsibilities for protecting and defending the Constitution.
- Inform people that the Constitution is the basis for America's great heritage and the foundation for our way of life.
- Encourage the study of historical events which led to the framing of the Constitution in September 1787.

Many observances will be taking place in the San Diego area. Be sure to fly your flag and take a little time to read our Constitution again. This helps us to become a more informed citizenry.



STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM OPPORTUNITY

Do you have a grandchild, friend or neighbor who is an 11th grade high school student in San Diego? Each year our Freedoms Foundation Chapter sends 10-12 students to Valley Forge, Pennsylvania for the "Spirit of America" Leadership Program and an extended trip to Washington D. C.

The process consists of the completion of an application, personal interview and selection. Many of the returning students call it a life-changing experience. They also take a greater leadership role in their school government.
